Drawing in October 2022

October has come around again so it's time to draw something every day - until it's time to not draw something everyday again. This year I am using my daily diary as the idea generator.

Creating a page can take anything from two to eight hours or more and the process goes something like this...

Thumbnails

Quick pencil doodles on cheap paper, working from my handwritten diary dictates what is going to go into the panel.

Pencil Drawing

Getting the proportions, composition and details down in the sketchbook more accurately so there is less chance of making a mistake when the inking starts.

Inking

Using a dip pen and ink to create the line work, crosshatching and mark making. The witty title comes last, riffing on the drawing and the diary entry. Mistakes do happen and that's where the 'white out' comes in. Although that creates a problem with applying watercolour over the top. That's where Photoshop comes in.

Colouring

Erase the pencil then apply watercolour to areas of the ink drawing that I think are important. I knew I would be scanning the sketchbook pages and didn't aim to colour in everything, just the focal points. Used Photoshop to tweak some of the colours and to drop in a colour overlay here and there.

It's all very mundane.

The ENTIRE day was spent, preparing to NATCH the NEW HEURAISER MOVIE in the evening. It did not disappoint!




LUNCH WITH A WE FRIEND

SECRET WORLD




The thing about drawing outside in the under GROWIH is people are OBLIVIOUS to my RRESENCE.


Nature MARKS


BRAMSINVASES


YOU CAN FIX ANYTHING WITH THE RIGHT FLAMER

Tidied up the garden, sweeping up the REMAINS of Summer. Filling the BIN ready for the last collection of the year. It's all a METAPHOR of course.




MIDNIGHT MGGIC


GRANGE EXPECTATIONS

PIRATE content





A5 Seawhite Sketchbook (140gsm, Hardcased)

The best sketchbooks I've used. The paper is sized and takes ink really well with very little to no bleed and the paper does not buckle too much either with adding watercolour.

Vintage Perry & Co No. 227 EF Nib

I was given a box of these a few years ago and feel it's my duty to use them all before I die. They are a good, flexible drawing nib.

Black Indian Ink Winsor & Newton

A reliable, strong ink that covers well and can be diluted to flow better with a nib. Waterproof when dry.

Cotman Watercolour Winsor & Newton

Transparent Cotman Watercolours, usually applied with a water bush.

Acylic White Ink Winsor & Newton

Goes over most ink and watercolour in a solid opaque layer.

- + Tippex, coloured pencils, paper patches and glue.
- + Digital clean-up of scanned drawings and colour overlays applied in Photoshop.
- + Pdf created with Affinity Publisher
